IFMA Foundation - The International Faculty Management Association Foundation has a Balanced Scorecard on their website with a strategy map, measures, and initiatives.

The Commonwealth Fund - A Private Foundation Working Toward a Higher Performance Health System, has a great white paper about performance scorecards, written by John E. Craig, COO.

Rural Hospitals - **The Rural Health Resource Center** provides MS Word based templates to help regional healthcare organizations plan for the Balanced Scorecard. On this site, there are also testimonials from 7 CEOs about how the BSC has helped their organization.
